### **STREET CLOSURES IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA: Aug – September 2019 Updated August 2, 2019**

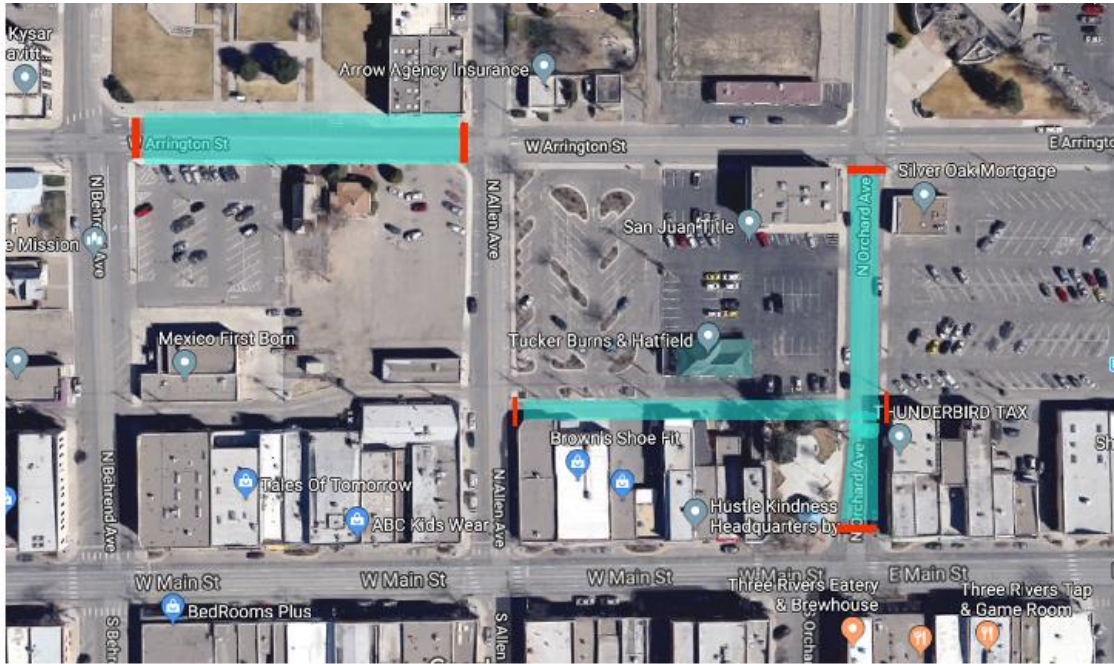
#### **Local Food Summit: permit approved**
